



Certified Healthcare Simulation Educator-Advanced® Renewal Materials

Certification as a Certified Healthcare Simulation Educator-Advanced® promotes excellence and professionalism, and demonstrates leadership in healthcare simulation as well as commitment to the use of simulation as a professional developmental tool.

The Certified Healthcare Simulation Educator-Advanced® (CHSE-A®) certifies individuals who demonstrate they are leaders in healthcare simulation and have demonstrated their expertise in the field. The certificant is required to maintain certification by fulfilling continuing professional development (CPD) requirements, which are reviewed and established annually by the Certification Council of the Society for Simulation in Healthcare. CHSE-A® certification **must** recertify through submission of CPD.

Recertification Requirements:

1. Obtaining and maintaining documentation of 45 continuing professional development units over the 3-year recertification cycle
2. Payment of a recertification fee.

All CPD must relate to areas covered in the most current CHSE® examination content outline. Applicants for renewal as a CHSE-A® must still meet the initial CHSE-A® eligibility requirements to be eligible for renewal.

ALL continuing professional development documentation should be kept on file by the individual applying for recertification for a period of at least 3 years. A random audit of continuing professional development units may be performed at any time during the recertification cycle. If audited, supporting materials must match the items provided by the. Self study items will be audited by asking the candidate's supervisor to verify the information provided.

Renewal Cycle:

Each renewal cycle is 3 years in length, beginning on the date of initial certification (first as a CHSE®). Certificants should apply for renewal no later than 30 days prior to the date of expiration of the current certification (i.e. an individual certified on April 15, 2013, should reapply by March 15, 2016). During each 3-year cycle, 45 continuing professional development (CPD) units are required. The CPD shall be entered into the online candidate management system.

A minimum of 1 unit in each Domain is required.

Domains include:

1. Educational Principles Applied to Simulation
2. Healthcare and Simulation Knowledge/Principle
3. Professional Values and Capabilities
4. Simulation Resources and Environments

All continuing professional development that follows the CHSE® Content Outline is accepted. Content related to healthcare simulation and education, including but not limited to debriefing, education theory, assessment, adult learning, patient safety, healthcare quality, or teamwork and/or communication principles will generally be accepted.

The detailed description of items in each Domain can be found by downloading the CHSE® Examination Blueprint.

Clinical content will NOT be accepted.

The following items are some examples of, but not limited to, continuing professional development for CHSE-A® recertification:

Seminar/Webinar Attendance: Participation in a lecture, workshop, or professional development session provided by a professional healthcare simulation or professional development association/society, healthcare facility, or an industry-recognized provider of professional development. Multiple participations in the same course may be counted only once. The provider must either award continuing professional development units, or be able to demonstrate that appropriate educational design methods were used for content.

Self-Study: Online professional developmental programs, article summarization.

Professional Speaking/Teaching: Examples include presentation/abstracts made by you at an international, national, regional, or local professional/society. Presentations given as part of your work responsibilities are NOT accepted for recertification.

Formal Publication of Articles of Books: Authoring a chapter in a published book or a peer-reviewed journal.

Items submitted should be at the level of performance expected of a CHSE-A®.

Entering Items Into the Certification Candidate Management System:

CPD activities can be entered at any time during the three-year certification cycle.

The steps to enter CPD activities into the system are as follows:

1. Go to www.simcertification.com and log in to the SSH system.
2. Click on the Candidate Management System links that can be found on any of the certification pages or on your “My SSH” page.
3. Click on the Certification tab; you will be able to see your certification and status such as expiration date.
4. Click on the ADD Continuing Professional Development Units button.
5. Enter the following information for each CPD item:
 - a. Provider Type (this is the type of activity)
 - b. Provider Name (such as the conference, name of the session, article title, etc)
 - c. CPD Type (this is the Domain that the activity best fits)
 - d. Quantity (such as the number of hours attending a conference, the number of semester hours for a college course, etc)
6. Click on Save.

Each entry for that three-year certification cycle that has been entered will appear in the Summary area. The entry by domain will also be tracked.

CPD activities that are entered are randomly audited. You will receive an email with the information regarding the audit, and where to submit verification.

Completing Your Renewal:

Renewal can be completed during the last three (3) months of the certification cycle (the last 3 months before the expiration date).

To complete the renewal:

1. Go to www.simcertification.com and log in to the SSH system.
2. Click on the Candidate Management System links that can be found on any of the certification pages or on your “My SSH” page.
3. Click on the Certification tab; you will be able to see your certification and status such as expiration date.
4. Click on the green Renew Now button. This will create a renewal folder (which can be found on the Application tab if you do not automatically get directed there).
5. If not already open, click on the folder icon by the renewal listing.
6. Click through and verify the information in each of the tabs.
7. Payment is submitted towards the end of the tabs.

NOTE: your renewal will not be completed if you have an outstanding audit. Please submit the information as requested in the audit email.

Continuing Professional Development Units

This table is provided as a tool to help the certificant who is maintaining CHSE-A® certification to enter CPD information into the online candidate management system. Each of the types of activities listed will help the candidate to understand what is being entered. Please note that the type of activity is not typically restricted to any one Domain, and the candidate must assign the Domain (a minimum of 1 CPD per Domain must be entered to be eligible for renewal).

Earns 4 continuing professional development units per year of service

Simulation Fellowship	SF	A fellowship in simulation from an approved organization.	Documentation of meeting the competencies necessary to complete fellowship	5 units per year of fellowship
Academic course development	ACD	Academic course developed and accepted as part of an accredited academic Curriculum (medical school, nursing school, etc). Content relates to an area of simulation, education, patient safety, healthcare quality or other applicable topic. Mentoring	M	Serve as a mentor for a student or professional related to simulation or professional development	Letter or other documents attesting to your service and dates of service.	2 units per student mentored per 6 month period
