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Society for Simulation in Healthcare members may apply for or nominate another member for the Society's annual **Researcher of the Year Award**. The deadline to nominate yourself or a colleague is XX.

Each year, the SSH **Researcher of the Year Award** is offered to a member whose body of work reflects excellence in simulation-based research, and which has had a significant impact on the field.

In order to be considered for this award, the member (or member nominator in conjunction with the nominee) must submit:

1. The Award application form
2. CV
3. Two letters of recommendation (maximum 2 pages each, with no attachments) describing the nominee's suitability for the SSH Researcher of the Year Award.

The award extends beyond the year in question. Rather, considerations for the award include:

- Quality, quantity, and impact of published simulation research
- A sustained national or international reputation as an independent and/or team investigator and major contributor in advancing the field of healthcare simulation
- Exceptional scholarship including first or senior authorship on significant simulation research publications
- Distinctive role in collaborative research
- Service as a simulation science reviewer or editor for journals or peer-reviewed grants
- Record of extramural funding
- Mentor to trainees in simulation-based studies

A panel convened by the SSH Research Committee Chair reviews and recommends to the SSH Board of Directors (the Board) up to 3 candidates for consideration of this annual award. The Board makes a final decision. The award is presented at the annual International Meeting on Simulation in Healthcare.
